On Monday of this week we were credited with over \$6 million dollars in contributions, pledges and estate giving toward our fiftieth reunion legacy gift goal of \$6.3 million dollars for the 63 Center for Academic Excellence. This is a major milestone. One that says we can make our goal with an increased stroke and an All Hands effort as we approach the finish line at the end of next month.

We are approaching seventy percent overall class participation in our efforts, with twelve companies over 63% participation and four more within two pecentage points of that goal.
