Class of 1963 Center for Academic Excellence Raffle Rules

- 1. Orders may be placed by mail using the official order form on the reverse or copy thereof and sent to the address indicated.
- 2. Ticket orders by mail must be received no later than October 15, 2013. Ticket orders and checks received after October 15, 2013 will be returned to sender.
- 3. All ticket sales are final at time of purchase. **There are no refunds.**
- 4. Winning tickets cannot be assigned, transferred or sold. The date for the First Prize must be mutually arranged between the winner and donor. The Grand Prize and the Class of 1963 Foundation Prize will be available for delivery at the Class of 1963 dinner on October 25, 2013. Optional shipping arrangements will be arranged with the winner, if desired.
- 5. Winners will be drawn one at a time from among all stubs of tickets sold. They will be drawn in the following order: The first ticket stub drawn will be for the Class of 1963 Foundation Prize; Second ticket stub drawn will be for the First Prize; and the third ticket stub drawn will be for the Grand Prize; the fourth ticket stub drawn will be for the Premier Prize; and the fifth ticket stub drawn will be for the 1962 Army-Navy prize.
- 6. A maximum of 1,000 tickets will be available for purchase. Odds of winning will be based on the number of tickets sold. Number of tickets sold will be announced at the time of the drawing.
- 7. Attendance is not required to win. Results will be posted on the Class of 1963 website on or before October 27, 2013 at www.usna63.org/foundation.
