CITATION:

For exceptionally meritorious service for operations during a period in November 1962 against an entrenched military adversary far superior in numbers and firepower. With boldest planning and execution, clandestine forces of Sixth Company's first class penetrated and assaulted the adversary's most formidable fortifications. By stealth and superior coordination they were able carry out a dangerous mission which upset the battlefield balance, and sowed the seeds for ultimate victory on the field. The great courage, aggressiveness, intrepidity, resourcefulness, persistence, professionalism, courage, verve and gallantry displayed by men of Sixth Company reflected great credit on themselves and their drags, and were in keeping with highest traditions of the United States Naval Service.
